



Brit Chadashah Blessings -

Thanking God for the New Covenant Scriptures

הִנֵּה יָמִים בָּאִים נְאֻם־יְהוָה וְכָרַתִּי אֶת־בְּרִית יִשְׂרָאֵל וְאֶת־בְּרִית יְהוּדָה בְּרִית חֲדָשָׁה

Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah. - Jer 31:31

The New Testament is called *B'rit HaChadashah* in Hebrew, meaning “the New Covenant” (the word *B'rit* means “covenant” and *Chadashah* means “new”). Just like the Torah and Haftarah blessings, Messianic Jewish believers thank the LORD God of Israel for the gift of the New Covenant Scriptures before and after reading from them.

Blessing Before Reading the Brit Chadashah

A blessing you can recite **before** reading from the New Covenant Scriptures is:

asher natan lanu Mashiach Yeshua
ve-hadiberot shel ha-berit chadashah.
Barukh attah Adonai, notein ha-berit ha-chadashah.*



Blessing After Reading the Brit Chadashah

A blessing you can recite **after** reading from the New Covenant Scriptures is:
